Itinerary Outline for

Friendly Games & Sightseeing/Paris; Friendly Game & Sightseeing/Rome; San Marino Cup/San Marino. June 26-July 10, 2005.

June 26: Depart San Diego for an overnight flight to Paris, France. After making one connection, the flight will be non-stop, with arrival in Paris early in the morning of the 27th.

June 27: Upon arrival in Paris, and after clearing French Customs and Immigration, your group will be met by a local representative and a privately chartered bus. Your local representative and privately chartered bus will be on hand on a full time basis, insuring that your stay in the Paris area goes smoothly. You will be transferred to a tourist class hotel located on the outskirts of the city of Paris. A daily buffet breakfast will be included for all travelers at the hotel. Players will be in double rooms

After checking in and unpacking, the team will have a light training session at a local club to help shake off the cobwebs following the trans-Atlantic journey. The remainder of the evening will be free.

June 28: Following breakfast, the group will have a guided tour of Paris. You will see many of the famous sights that make this one of the world's most famous cities. The Eiffel Tower, the Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysees, the Louvre and Notre Dame Cathedral are only a few of the many famous places that you will see and learn about. In the afternoon, you will spend some time at the Eiffel Tower (tickets to the top included) before going on a cruise of the Seine River.

Late in the afternoon the team will transfer to a local club where the teams will play a friendly game against a local club team similar to your own. After transferring back to the hotel the remainder of the evening will be free.

June 29: After breakfast the group will transfer to Versailles, about an hour outside the city of Paris. This is the site of the incredible Palace and grounds built by Louis XIV centuries ago. The group will have a guided sightseeing tour here.

In the afternoon you will transfer back to Paris, where you will have some free time for shopping and sightseeing in the city.

This evening the teams will play another friendly game against a local team.

June 30: In the morning the group will have a tour of France's national stadium, the Stade de France. In the afternoon there will be more free time at leisure in Paris for more informal sightseeing and shopping.

Tonight the group will have a farewell dinner at a restaurant featuring the local cuisine known as "guingettes."

July 1: Following breakfast the Paris Charles DeGaulle International Airport, where you will board a flight to Rome, Italy.

Upon arrival in Rome, your group will be met by another privately chartered bus and a local representative. You will then be transported to your accommodations, a tourist class hotel located near the city center of Rome. Players will be accommodated in triple rooms while here, with breakfasts and dinners included daily.

The remainder of the day will be free for some informal sightseeing and shopping on your own.

July 2: After breakfast at the hotel, the group will have a half day guided tour of Rome, one of the world's most famous and historical places. You will see the famous Roman Coliseum, the Vatican Museum, the incredible artwork and architecture that make Rome so interesting.

Although the formal part of the sightseeing tour will take only a half day, the remainder of the day will be spent in the city so that you may enjoy walking the streets and enjoying the incredible atmosphere of this great city.

July 3: This morning the group will transfer back to the city and have a tour of the famous Vatican City, home to the Pope and an incredible array of art and history.

In the afternoon the group will transfer to a local sports center where the teams will play a friendly match against a local team.

July 4: Transfer by bus to San Marino. The Republic of San Marino is home to the San Marino Cup tournament, a small but high quality event which will bring teams from ten different nations together for four days of soccer and fun. 2005 will be the fifth year for this event, which has quickly earned a reputation as one of Europe's premier tournaments. After checking in at the tournament headquarters, you will transfer to your accommodations.

Once again the group will be accommodated in a tourist class hotel located very near the city center. Breakfasts will be provided daily at the hotel, and dinners will be included for everyone at the San Marino Cup tournament restaurant.

July 5: After breakfast this morning the tournament games begin and continue all day. Teams are grouped in brackets of 4, and the preliminary rounds of the event see

each team play the others in the group. After group play, the top two teams advance to the final rounds of the tournament, and the 3rd and 4th place finishers in each group are then re-bracketed to play in a consolation tournament.

In the evening all teams participating in the San Marino Cup will gather at the Olympic Stadium where an impressive Opening Ceremonies will take place.

- July 6: Second and third preliminary games take place. During the times when the team is not playing, there will be lots of opportunity to go explore the sights of the area, including the old town of San Marino, which features an medieval castle and many shops.
- July 7: First round tournament games continue. This evening in the city center there is a performance featuring local musicians and dancers. The show will be a reproduction of a medieval festival.
- July 8: Tournament semi-finals take place today. In addition, the San Marino Cup organizes a “mini-tournament” for the coaches today which might be of interest. In the evening the tournament sponsors a disco for all participants.
- July 9: The last day of the San Marino features the finals in all age groups. If your team is not playing, you can take an excursion, for example to the nearby seaside resort of Rimini.
- July 10: After breakfast the group will check out of the hotel and transfer by bus to the airport in Bologna, about an hour and a half drive from San Marino. From Bologna you will board a connecting flight to Paris and back to the USA.

Prices per person:

Players/Staff: \$3,495.00*

*This price reflects double occupancy in Paris and triple occupancy in Italy and San Marino. For double occupancy in Italy and San Marino add \$70.00 per person. For single occupancy add \$40.00 per person, per night in each location.

The prices noted for the above outline itinerary includes the following:

- Round trip airfare as noted via regularly scheduled carrier; San Diego-Paris; Bologna-San Diego.
- One way air fare from Paris-Rome on July 1.
- Privately chartered motor coach available on a full time basis from June 27-July 1 in Paris, and from July 1 through July 10 in Italy and San Marino.
- Accommodations for twelve nights as noted; in a tourist class hotels (3 star) in each location. All rooms will have private bathrooms and shower facilities. Double occupancy in Paris and triple occupancy in Italy and San Marino.
- Daily breakfasts in and a farewell dinner on June 30 in Paris; two meals daily in Rome and San Marino.
- Full sports program to include two friendly games and training sessions in Paris as noted, one friendly game in Rome, and participation in the appropriate age group of the San Marino Cup tournament.
- Guided sightseeing tours of Paris, Versailles and the Stade de France as noted, in addition to a Seine River sightseeing cruise. Guided tours of Paris and Vatican City as noted.
- Services of a local representative for your group at each stop.
- Pre-trip assistance and administration from East-West Team Travel.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Tour Cost: The price per traveler for the Mesa College Alumni tour of France, Italy and San Marino as outlined is \$3,495.00. In order to make this as manageable as possible for you, and also to enable us to make financial commitments on your behalf to our various overseas suppliers, we have devised a schedule of payments which divides this amount equally over the next several months.

Deposit: A deposit of \$500.00 per traveler will be required to hold and confirm a place on tour. \$300.00 of this amount is non refundable should you decide to cancel your participation at a later date. Of course, this deposit will be credited fully towards the cost of your trip.

Suggested Payment Schedule: Once the deposit has been received, the remaining balance due will be split into five equal payments, with the final payment being due by May 21, 2005. A summary of the payment schedule is as follows:

Due January 7, 2005	\$600.00
Due February 21, 2005	\$600.00
Due April 7, 2005	\$600.00
Due May 21, 2005:	\$595.00

Credit Card Payments: Credit card payments with VISA, DISCOVER or MASTERCARD will be accepted for any fees associated with the tour.

Cancellation and Refund Policy: As a general rule, please note that we will always endeavor to refund to any player as much money as is retrievable at the time of cancellation. However, because we are bound by the restrictions imposed upon us by suppliers such as airlines, ground operators, etc., we need to make sure that you also are aware of the cancellation fees involved. If a traveler withdraws from the tour after money has been paid to East-West Team Travel, the following fees will apply:

If cancellation is prior to April 7, 2005, there will be no penalty other than the forfeit of \$300.00 of the deposit, which is non-refundable from the time of receipt.

If cancellation is between April 7 and May 21, 2005, all monies paid to East-West Team Travel will be refunded, less the entire deposit (\$500.00) and a \$100.00 cancellation fee.

If cancellation is after May 21, 2005, no refunds will be available.

Deviation Charges: Deviations from the main (group) itinerary are welcome and normally easily accomplished if reasonable prior notice is given. Until April 1, 2005, any and all requests for deviations will be dealt with at no charge (other than the actual difference in whatever plans are to be made). After this date, there will be a charge of \$75.00 per person for any deviation from the main itinerary, in addition to the normal charges incurred.

Trip Cancellation Insurance: In order to protect yourself against the penalties outlined above, in addition to any unforeseen circumstances that might cause you to withdraw from the tour, we recommend trip cancellation insurance. If you would like more information about this, please contact the East-West Team Travel office.

Responsibility and Liability: The responsibility of East-West Team Travel, the foreign ground operators, tournament organizers, and host organizations is limited. East-West Team Travel acts in the capacity of an agent for the participants in all matters pertaining to the tour, such as (but not limited to) the arrangement of transportation, accommodations, meals, sightseeing, social and cultural activities, and the sports program. East-West Team Travel, its suppliers, foreign tournament organizers and hosting organizations including host clubs are not responsible for any personal injury, illness or death, nor any loss, damage or theft of belongings, nor for any error, accident, delay, deviation or curtailment of any kind caused directly by any actions, omissions, acts of failure by:

- a) Any person or company retained for the benefit of the participant, including, but not limited to transportation, housing, and tour guides;
- b) Acts of God, public enemy, arrest or restraint by any government, seizure under legal process, quarantine restrictions, riots of civil commotions, strikes, lockouts or labor stoppages, war hazards or dangers incident to the state of war;
- c) Any defect or failure to comply with any part of local rules or regulations of any airplane, automobile, motor coach, ship, train, or other vehicle.
- d) Improper or insufficient passports or other documents.

Additional expense incurred under any of these circumstances will be the sole responsibility of the tour participants.

General: East-West Team Travel will assume that the responsible tour leader, participants and their parents or legal guardians, are in agreement with the conditions mentioned above, and that all engagements with East-West Team Travel have been undertaken by an authorized person. These conditions are applicable to all agreements between East-West Team Travel and any party.
