Itinerary Outline for THE 2006 FC BRATZ EUROPEAN TOUR

Friendly Games, Koblenz, Germany; Donosti Cup Tournament, San Sebastian Spain. June 24-July 9, 2006.

June 24: Depart San Diego for Frankfurt, Germany. After connecting, arrival in Frankfurt will be the morning of June 25.

June 25: Upon arrival in Frankfurt and after clearing German Customs and Immigration, your group will be met by a local representative and a privately chartered bus.

Of course, Germany is the host nation for the 2006 FIFA World Cup. Millions of people from every corner of the world will be in Germany during the month long event, creating an exciting and international atmosphere. Your group will be based in the German city of Koblenz, located approximately 60 miles to the west of Frankfurt, and within easy access to at least six World Cup venue cities. During the week you are in Germany, the first round matches will have been completed, and the matches of the round of 16, the quarter finals and the semi-finals will be played (see attached schedule). It will be an exciting time to be in Germany, especially if the host country is still involved in the tournament!

You will transfer to your hotel local very near the city center of Koblenz. Players will be accommodated in triple rooms, and any accompanying adults will be in double and single rooms, as needed. Each morning, breakfasts will be included and served in the hotel restaurant.

June 26-
July 1: During your stay in Germany, each team will play two friendly matches against local German teams. In addition, you will have access to a local sports club for training sessions, as desired. In addition, your final itinerary will feature an appropriate blend of sightseeing and cultural activities. Among the trip highlights will surely be a dinner cruise of the Rhine River. In addition the group will have a day trip to the nearby city of Cologne, a World Cup City. You will have a guided tour of this historic city which has a historic old town and one of the world's largest gothic cathedrals. World Cup matches are scheduled to take place on June 26th in Cologne and Kaiserslautern, each venue within easy access from Koblenz. On July 1 Quarterfinal games will be played in Frankfurt and Gelsenkirchen, also easily reached from Koblenz. Even without tickets to the games, you will have the chance to travel to these cities on the dates of the matches to take in the incredible atmosphere. (Note: World Cup match are tickets not included nor guaranteed in this itinerary. For information regarding tickets, please refer to the following web site: www.fifa.com). Another possible excursion during this time is a trip to Luxembourg, a neighboring country within easy driving distance.

July 2: After breakfast your bus will transfer the group to the airport in Frankfurt, where you will catch a flight to San Sebastian, Spain. After connecting in Madrid, you will arrive in San Sebastian in the early afternoon.

The seaside resort of San Sebastian is the home of the Donosti Cup tournament. Your group will arrive at the tournament headquarters for check in and then be taken to your accommodations.

While in San Sebastian, the players and staff will be accommodated in a hotel located near the center of the city, with players in triple bedded rooms and adults in double or single rooms. Three meals per day will be included for all tour participants. Once again the group will have a privately chartered bus available on a full time basis to handle all ground transportation needs conveniently and in comfort.

July 3-8: The Donosti Cup tournament is gaining a reputation as one of Europe's premier youth tournaments. With an emphasis on quality both on and off the playing fields, this tournament offers a tremendous experience for anyone who participates. For the Donosti Cup 2006, 200 teams from 20 different soccer playing nations are expected. All teams are guaranteed a minimum of four games during the tournament, which is played at several sites in and around the city of San Sebastian. Teams are bracketed in groups of 4, and after playing each other, the next phase of the tournament begins. The top two teams from each group advance in the tournament, and the third and fourth place teams from each group continue play in a consolation tournament.

The tournament begins on July 3 with the first games and impressive Opening Ceremonies at the stadium of Real Sociedad. The event comes to a close with the finals which are played on Saturday, July 8. The tournament organizes many activities for the players and group members for the times when games are not being played. In addition, there will be time for some sightseeing excursions to local points of interest, to be determined during the tournament week. You will have the opportunity to take excursions to such places as St. Jean de Luz, a picturesque French fishing village just across the border, Pamplona, where the famous Running of the Bulls takes place, and perhaps Bilbao, where the famous Guggenheim Museum of Art is located. With the help of your local representative all of these and more are possible.

July 9: After breakfast the group will check out of the accommodations and transfer by bus to the airport in Bilbao. From here the group will connect in Madrid and Chicago before arriving back in San Diego.

Price per person, full tour: \$3,950.00*

Land-Only Price per Person: \$2,400.00**

*The price noted reflects triple occupancy in Germany and triple occupancy in San Sebastian. For double occupancy in each location, please add \$175.00 per person to the price noted above. For single occupancy in each location, please add an additional \$45.00 per person, per night.

**Land-Only price reflects the entire tour itinerary as noted with the exception of air fare to and from San Diego, in addition to the air fare between Frankfurt and San Sebastian on July 2.

The price noted for the above outline itinerary includes the following:

- Air fare as noted via regularly scheduled carrier from San Diego to Frankfurt on June 24, from Frankfurt to San Sebastian (or nearest convenient airport) on July 2, and from Bilbao, Spain to San Diego on July 9.
- All ground transfers to be provided by a privately chartered bus and driver. Bus transportation provided for transfers noted on the itinerary only while in Germany (June 25-July 2), and on a full time basis while in Spain (July 2-9).
- Accommodations for fourteen nights as noted; in a three star hotel in Koblenz, Germany as noted from June 25-July 2, and a four star hotel in San Sebastian from July 2-9. All rooms will have private bathrooms and shower facilities.
- Daily breakfasts plus two evening meals in Germany between June 25 and July 2, and 3 meals daily in San Sebastian between July 2 and July 9.
- Sports program to include two friendly games for each team in Germany, and participation in the appropriate age group of the Donosti Cup tournament.
- Services of a bilingual local representative at each location.
- Sightseeing excursions as noted, to include a city tour of Cologne and a Rhine River Cruise in Germany, assorted excursions in Spain to be determined with the assistance of the local representatives.
- Pre-trip administration and assistance from East-West Team Travel.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Tour Cost: The price per traveler for the FC Bratz/Mesa College Alumni tour of Germany and Spain as outlined is \$3,950.00. In order to make this as manageable as possible for you, and also to enable us to make financial commitments on your behalf to our various overseas suppliers, we have devised a schedule of payments which divides this amount equally over the next several months.

Deposit: A deposit of \$500.00 per traveler will be required to hold and confirm a place on tour. \$300.00 of this amount is non-refundable should you decide to cancel your participation at a later date. Of course, this deposit will be credited fully towards the cost of your trip.

Suggested Payment Schedule: Once the deposit has been received, the remaining balance due will be split into five equal payments, with the final payment being due by May 14, 2006. A summary of the payment schedule is as follows:

Credit Card Payments: Credit card payments with VISA, DISCOVER or MASTERCARD will be accepted for any fees associated with the tour.

Cancellation and Refund Policy: As a general rule, please note that we will always endeavor to refund to any player as much money as is retrievable at the time of cancellation. However, because we are bound by the restrictions imposed upon us by suppliers such as airlines, ground operators, etc., we need to make sure that you also are aware of the cancellation fees involved. If a traveler withdraws from the tour after money has been paid to East-West Team Travel, the following fees will apply:

If cancellation is prior to April 1, 2006, there will be no penalty other than the forfeit of \$300.00 of the deposit, which is non-refundable from the time of receipt.

If cancellation is between April 1 and May 14, 2006, all monies paid to East-West Team Travel will be refunded, less the entire deposit (\$500.00) and a \$100.00 cancellation fee.

If cancellation is after May 14, 2006, no refunds will be available.

Deviation Charges: Deviations from the main (group) itinerary are welcome and normally easily accomplished if reasonable prior notice is given. Until April 1, 2006, any and all requests for deviations will be dealt with at no charge (other than the actual difference in whatever plans are to be made). After this date, there will be a charge of \$75.00 per person for any deviation from the main itinerary, in addition to the normal charges incurred.

Trip Cancellation Insurance: In order to protect yourself against the penalties outlined above, in addition to any unforeseen circumstances that might cause you to withdraw from the tour, we recommend trip cancellation insurance. If you would like more information about this, please contact the East-West Team Travel office. This insurance is strongly recommended.

Responsibility and Liability: The responsibility of East-West Team Travel, the foreign ground operators, tournament organizers, and host organizations is limited. East-West Team Travel acts in the capacity of an agent for the participants in all matters pertaining to the tour, such as (but not limited to) the arrangement of transportation, accommodations, meals, sightseeing, social and cultural activities, and the sports program. East-West Team Travel, its suppliers, foreign tournament organizers and hosting organizations including host clubs are not responsible for any personal injury, illness or death, nor any loss, damage or theft of belongings, nor for any error, accident, delay, deviation or curtailment of any kind caused directly by any actions, omissions, acts of failure by:

- a) Any person or company retained for the benefit of the participant, including, but not limited to transportation, housing, and tour guides;
- b) Acts of God, public enemy, arrest or restraint by any government, seizure under legal process, quarantine restrictions, riots of civil commotions, strikes, lockouts or labor stoppages, war hazards or dangers incident to the state of war;
- c) Any defect or failure to comply with any part of local rules or regulations of any airplane, automobile, motor coach, ship, train, or other vehicle.
- d) Improper or insufficient passports or other documents.

Additional expense incurred under any of these circumstances will be the sole responsibility of the tour participants.

General: East-West Team Travel will assume that the responsible tour leader, participants and their parents or legal guardians, are in agreement with the conditions mentioned above, and that all engagements with East-West Team Travel have been undertaken by an authorized person. These conditions are applicable to all agreements between East-West Team Travel and any party.
